



EMT Reciprocity Information

Taking a rapid progression EMT class at SOLO Southeast does *not guarantee* EMT Certification

At SOLO Southeast, our class gives you the training and skills to become an Emergency Medical Technician. The class we run is approved by the Department Of Transportation, National Registry and the state of North Carolina. Following completion of the class, you **MUST** pass either the National Registry exam or the North Carolina exam, and meet all other requirements. Taking the class does not guarantee passing these tests. Once the course has been completed, we will then inform the National Registry and state of North Carolina that you have reached the standard required to sit in on the State and National Registry exams. You may take the National Registry in any state.

If you plan on working in a state outside North Carolina as a street EMT, requirements vary considerably from state to state. Passing your National Registry exam does not always guarantee automatic reciprocity from another state. In order to get reciprocity, you will often need to complete a background check, fill out an application form and complete specific requirements for your home state.

These requirements are constantly changing. We have attached a summary sheet of state by state requirements and contact information for all states. This information is by no means comprehensive and you will need to contact your state office of EMS. Some states require both National Registry certification and state certification (from the state where you completed the class) to allow for reciprocity.

We have a very high pass rate at SOLO Southeast and with plenty of hard work and late nights we feel confident that most students will go on to pass both our classroom exam and the National Registry exam. We will also do everything possible to guide you through the steps to gain reciprocity within your state should you need it.

State requirements vary. Passing our class does not guarantee that you will be able to receive a state or NREMT license. Other possible requirements include but are not limited to background checks, state specific training or exams, and department affiliation.

We also cannot guarantee that you will be able to obtain a license in a timely manner. It can take months to complete these processes.
