College Credits for SOLO Wilderness Medicine Courses via Sterling College

SOLO is partnered with Sterling College to be able to offer college credits to their students for their Wilderness & Emergency Medicine Courses.

Please refer below for a summary of how to apply to Sterling College, Craftsbury Common, VT, for College Credits.

College credits will be applied as follows:

Applied Sciences – Technical Skills

Wilderness First Aid/Wilderness First Responder Recertification – 1 credit

Advanced Wilderness First Aid – 2 credits

Wilderness MODULE for EMTs – 3 credits

Wilderness First Responder – 4 credits

Wilderness EMT – 8 credits

(Wilderness First Responder – 4 credits PLUS WEMT “Part II” – 4 credits = 8 credits = WEMT)

Steps for Students and SOLO Sponsors to know...

1. Student registers for SOLO Wilderness Medicine course with SOLO Southeast
2. SOLO Southeast emails student’s registration info to Sterling College, Attn: Laura Lea Berry, Sterling College Registrar, at: lberry@sterlingcollege.edu (Contact phone #: 802-586-7711, ext: 107). *i.e. Letter of Course Enrollment Verification. SOLO Southeast **SHOULD/WILL** cc the student with this email & Letter of Course Enrollment Verification! This will allow the student to know that the Letter has been sent to Sterling College.*
3. SOLO Southeast Instructor will email Laura Lea Berry with student’s final grade (Only a grade of “C” or better will receive course credit.)
4. Laura Lea Berry will mail transcript to student’s college or university of choice if college credits fee (\$130/Credit) and \$15 Transcript Submission Fee have been paid to Sterling College.
